



Gill Sturtridge First-Time Speaker Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded from the donations given in her memory by the family and friends of Gill Sturtridge. The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage a member of IATEFL to give his/her first talk at an IATEFL Annual Conference.

The award consists of:

- registration for a Pre-Conference Event of the winner's choice
- registration for the IATEFL Annual Conference
- GBP 1000.00 towards conference related expenses

To qualify you must:

- be a newcomer to the profession with between three and ten years' experience in ELT
- agree to give a talk at the IATEFL Annual Conference
- be a member of IATEFL (see <https://members.iatefl.org> for the different membership types) who has not previously presented at the IATEFL Annual Conference

To be considered, you must submit:

- an online speaker proposal on a topic of your choice by the scholarship deadline
- a 400 – 500 word statement:
 - describing a recent successful lesson you have given
 - listing the factors that made it successful
 - drawing broad conclusions regarding your future teaching practice

The submission deadline is **16.00 (UK time) on Thursday 12th July 2018**. Early submissions are very welcome; late submissions will not be considered.

The results will be announced between Tuesday 28th August 2018 and Friday 7th September 2018. Please do NOT contact the IATEFL Head Office about scholarship decisions; the Scholarship Committee will send everyone the results as soon as they are available.
