

LT123 Brazil State Sector Scholarship

This scholarship has been established to enable a Brazilian state sector teacher or teacher-trainer to attend the conference. LT123 wish to facilitate somebody who might not otherwise find financial support for the trip. We hope that the insights and contacts gained will be of lasting value within the state education sector to the successful applicant and their colleagues.

The award consists of:

- registration for a Pre-Conference Event of the winner's choice
- registration for the IATEFL Annual Conference
- GBP 1500.00 towards conference-related costs (travel, subsistence etc.)

To qualify you must:

- be a native of and normally resident in Brazil
- work wholly or mainly within the state education sector in Brazil as a teacher or teacher-trainer
- agree to submit a 250-word article on your impressions of the conference, for possible publication by IATEFL and/or LT123, to the Scholarship Committee by June 2020
- agree to give a presentation at the IATEFL Annual Conference

To be considered, you must submit:

- an online speaker proposal by the scholarship deadline
- a statement of between 400 and 500 words:
 1. outlining your teaching context
 2. describing a recent successful lesson you have given
 3. listing the factors that made it successful
 4. drawing a broad conclusion regarding your future teaching practice

The submission deadline is **16.00 (UK time) on Thursday 4th July 2019**. Early submissions are very welcome; late submissions will not be considered.

The results will be announced between Tuesday 27th August 2019 and Friday 6th September 2019. Please do NOT contact the IATEFL Head Office about scholarship decisions; the Scholarship Committee will send everyone the results as soon as they are available.
