

Testing, Evaluation and Assessment SIG Scholarship

An IATEFL TEASIG Scholarship is an award for a teacher to attend the 2018 IATEFL Conference in Brighton and to give a presentation on the TEASIG Day.

The TEASIG scholarships are awarded for up to **two** teachers to attend the IATEFL Annual Conference and give a presentation in the TEASIG Showcase.

Applicants need not necessarily be members of TEASIG but should have an interest in membership of TEASIG and contributing actively to TEASIG through, for example, articles in the TEASIG Newsletter or TEASIG's web-based communication tools and/ or starting up and/or facilitating local events on Testing, Evaluation and Assessment in their home areas.

The award consists of

- registration for the TEASIG Pre-Conference Event
- registration for the IATEFL Annual Conference
- membership of TEASIG for one year, if applicable
- travel costs, including, if necessary, an economy-class flight to the UK up to a **maximum** of GBP 650.00 (this includes the cost of flights, airport transfers and any additional mobility requirements to attend the conference, but not stopovers).
- GBP 500.00 towards accommodation and UK expenses.

To qualify you must

- be a member of IATEFL when you apply
- be interested in becoming a member of TEASIG and participating actively in TEASIG, e.g. by attending or presenting at a TEASIG event, writing an article for the newsletter, contributing to the organization of a local event or in some other way
- be willing to give a presentation or a workshop on an aspect of Testing, Evaluation and / or Assessment during the TEASIG Showcase
- introduce yourself at the TEASIG Open Forum at the IATEFL Annual Conference
- write a report on your presentation and IATEFL conference experience for the TEASIG Newsletter by the end of June 2018.

To be considered for the scholarship you should apply online including:

- an online speaker proposal on a Testing, Evaluation and Assessment topic by the scholarship deadline of **Tuesday 18th July 2017**.
- a 400-500 summary outlining your interest in becoming active as a member of TEASIG
- a passport size photo (for inclusion in the conference programme and on the scholarship poster if you win – remember to smile! Please refer to the General Guidelines for full photo requirements)

The submission deadline is **16.00 (UK time) on Tuesday 18th July 2017**. Early submissions are very welcome; late submissions will not be considered.

The results will be announced between **Monday 28th August 2017** and **Thursday 7th September 2017**. Please do NOT contact the IATEFL Head Office about scholarship decisions; the Scholarship Working Party (SWP) will send everyone the results as soon as they are available.
