

Scholarship Sponsored by the *TOEFL*[®] Program

At ETS we aim to provide support to teachers worldwide and we are dedicated to giving teachers opportunity to realize their potential. This scholarship has been established to encourage and support English language teachers working in an English for Academic Purposes (EAP) setting to present their work to a larger international audience. The presentation should include the grantee's classroom research results or concern sharing practical tips and/or ideas for classroom activities that can help build necessary language skills crucial for effective use of English in an academic setting.

The award consists of:

- Registration for the IATEFL TEA SIG Pre-conference Event
- Registration for the IATEFL Annual Conference
- One-year IATEFL Membership
- GBP 800 towards conference expenses
- Mentoring from ETS for your presentation

To qualify you must:

- Be currently working as an EFL teacher/ lecturer
- Agree to present on EAP skill building or testing in the IATEFL Annual Conference and submit a proposal according to IATEFL's guidelines
- Have prepared learners for taking the *TOEFL iBT*[®] test
- Submitting an article on your conference experience within 6 months of the event

To be considered you should submit:

- An online speaker proposal by the scholarship deadline
- A summary of between 400 and 500 words explaining your approach to EAP assessment and related skill building techniques, strategies and sample activities you have created
- A brief description (50-75 words) of your experience in teaching the EAP classes over the past 18 months

The submission deadline is **16.00 (UK time) on Thursday 4th July 2019**. Early submissions are very welcome; late submissions will not be considered.

The results will be announced between Tuesday 27th August 2019 and Friday 6th September 2019. Please do NOT contact the IATEFL Head Office about scholarship decisions; the Scholarship Committee will send everyone the results as soon as they are available.
